Changemakers develops community involvement activity designed and managed by young people. Changemakers:

- harnesses young people's energy;
- challenges young people's idealism and/or discovers their values;
- addresses young people's interests and concerns;
- develops young people's qualities, skills, experience and a sense of active citizenship;
- offers young people a chance to make a difference to their own lives and to the lives of others; and
- helps young people to prepare themselves for a labour market which increasingly demands that they be proactive and self-managed.
